Procedures to be followed during the Examination Period

1. Pupils taking Music, Media Studies, Minority Languages or Other Languages are to refer to their respective centre schedules for details of their preliminary examinations. Pupils are to **inform Form Teachers early if there are clashes**. Pupils with Prelim Exams in September at these external centres will be excused from class after 11:20am. These pupils must complete an Early Release Form which is to be endorsed by her Form Teacher.
2. Pupils sitting for papers starting at 0800h are to attend the flag-raising ceremony.
3. Pupils should **check the seating plans** (on the notice-board near the spiral staircase) **at least one day** before the paper to locate their seats for each paper. (These **will change** with each paper)
4. All pupils must **assemble** (in classes according to index number) **in the Amphitheatre 20 minutes before the start of the paper**.
5. Pupils may leave after taking the last examination paper for the day.
6. Pupils are advised to be in school at least 30 minutes before the start of the paper and to bring food for their break just in case their break coincides with the recess of pupils from another level.
7. Class Representatives are to help take class attendance at the courtyard / amphitheatre on each exam day and report absentees to the teacher in charge.

Rules to be observed during the Examination Period

1. Pupils should wear the school uniform, not PE attire. The usual School rules apply.
2. Movement to and from the Examination Venue must be quick and silent.
3. Once in the examination room, pupils should refrain from talking place their bags at the designated area of the venue, find their seats and sit down.
4. Any student found cheating, attempting to cheat or abetting in cheating will face disciplinary action.
5. No communication is allowed between pupils while the examination is on.
6. Only dark blue and black ink pens should be used.
7. The borrowing of stationery, mathematical instruments etc from each other in the examination hall/room, is not permitted. Have the above materials ready BEFORE entering the exam venue.
8. Pupils are not permitted to have in their possession any unauthorized materials, electronic or communication devices when in the examination venue. They should also not remove any used or unused writing paper from the venue. Discard them in the bins located near the exits.
9. No eradicating liquid/correction pens/tape/whiteners are allowed. They will have to be surrendered.
10. When the invigilator gives instructions to stop writing, pupils are expected to do so immediately. Otherwise marks may be deducted for unfair advantage over other pupils.
11. No additional time will be given for the writing of names at the end of the paper. Do so as you start new sheets of paper.

If a pupil falls <u>sick</u> and is unable to sit for a paper, she <u>must call up the school</u> to inform her Form Teacher or the school office, <u>at least 30 minutes</u> before the start of the paper. A pupil who is absent for a paper <u>must produce a valid medical certificate</u> to cover her absence. Pupils absent for a paper <u>without a medical certificate will be given zero marks</u> for the paper that they missed. (MCs issued by "sinsehs" or practitioners of Traditional Chinese Medicine and letters from parents are not acceptable) |
