

SCGS Jinyu Meritorious Scholarship

Singapore Chinese Girls' School offers Jinyu Meritorious Scholarships ("SJM Scholarship") to students with outstanding talents to study in the independent Secondary School.

Students with excellent academic records or outstanding achievements in any field other than sports and games are welcomed to apply. (*Note: Outstanding sports girls should apply for the SCGS Sports Scholarship which is intended to recognise excellence in sports*)

Scholarship Details

The SCGS Jinyu Meritorious Scholarship shall cover:

- School fees as charged by SCGS for local students for the year. Should the scholar also be in receipt of any other scholarship or bursary covering all or part of such fees, the SJM Scholarship will cover only the difference between the student's school fees (local rate) and such other sum due to her as a benefit under any other scholarship or bursary.
- A monthly award of \$100 to cover educational expenses.

Subject to performance and conduct, and the conditions stated herein the scholarship will be renewed yearly to allow the scholar to continue her schooling in SCGS leading to the GCE 'O' Level Examination at the end of Secondary 4. Scholars, who received the scholarship for outstanding achievements in a recognised field, are required to continue to pursue for excellence in that field for the duration of her studies in SCGS.

Eligibility for Application

Applicants from other schools

1. Attained top academic positions in her school OR excellent results in national examinations/competitions OR achieve the equivalent standard in similar examinations/competitions overseas. [*The school reserves the right to accord its own ranking to such competitions.*]

2. Is testified to be of exemplary conduct and behaviour by 2 referees, one of whom must be her school teacher.

3. Passed a test (if required by SCGS) and an interview by appointed personnel of the school.

Applicants from SCGS

1. Attained top academic positions in SCGS OR excellent results in national examinations/competitions OR achieve the equivalent standard in similar examinations/competitions overseas. [*The school reserves the right to accord its own ranking to such competitions.*]

2. Is testified to be of exemplary conduct and behaviour by her teachers.

New Application

Application for the scholarship must be submitted by 15 January of the scholarship year on the requisite forms to:

For new applications, the following documents (photocopies) must be submitted together with the application form:

- Applicant's Birth Certificate or other Certificate of Identification
- Previous 2 years' academic records
- Other certificates or records in support of achievements declared in the application form

Renewal Application

Renewal Application for the scholarship must be submitted by 15 January of the scholarship year on the requisite forms to the Principal, Singapore Chinese Girls' School together with the following documents (photocopies):

- Previous year's academic records
- Other certificates or records in support of achievements during the previous year

Award

The School's decision on the award of the Scholarship is final and it will not enter into discussion or correspondence on the merits or otherwise of any award made.
